COURSES ACCEPTING STAT AS AN ADMISSION PATHWAY

The following tables list the courses at Curtin University, Edith Cowan University, Murdoch University, The University of Notre Dame Australia, and The University of Western Australia, which are offered through TISC. Each course for which STAT is accepted as an admission pathway in 2025 is indicated, and the STAT elements considered for those courses are identified. The universities may have additional requirements (such as pre-requisite courses at Year 12 level) for some courses.

Fees apply to sit STAT. Current fee information is listed on [TISC's website](#). STAT may not be the most appropriate entry pathway for all applicants with work and life experience – TISC

strongly encourages potential candidates to seek advice from the university/ies where they wish to study before booking for STAT.

APPLYING FOR UNIVERSITY USING STAT AS AN ADMISSION PATHWAY

Booking for and sitting STAT is a separate process to actually applying for university. If you are not a current-year Year 12 student, and are using STAT as your admission pathway, TISC recommends that you contact the university where you wish to study to confirm the preferred method of application – this may be via TISC, or direct to the university.

If you sit STAT in Western Australia, your results will be electronically available to the five WA universities. You will not need to provide them with a copy of your results.

CURTIN UNIVERSITY

Where it is possible to enter a course based on STAT results, the following indicates the STAT requirements for entry to Curtin courses in 2025. Note: WE = Written English test. MC = Multiple Choice test. Where courses do not accept STAT for entry, applicants are able to utilise the Written English component to demonstrate competence in English.
