### **2019 JANUARY ROUND UNIVERSITY OFFERS THROUGH TISC**

January round university offer information is now available to applicants on the Tertiary Institutions Service Centre's website, [www.tisc.edu.au](http://www.tisc.edu.au).

TISC received 16,457 applications in the 2018/2019 admissions period, including 12,107 from WACE students (last year: 17,708 applications, including 12,406 from WACE students).

86% of university applicants have received an offer. There were 14,101 offers made over the admissions period with 75% of offers going to first preferences. At the same time last year, the universities had made 15,142 offers, with 76% going to first preferences. 2018 WACE students received 11,264 offers for 2019 university entry (93% of WACE applicants). The 2017 WACE cohort received 11,513 offers for 2018 entry (93% of WACE applicants).

Since the December round, 8,175 people have accepted their offers (9,413 last year).

This year there were 2,290 new offers in the January round (1,727 last year). These were made to a mixture of new applicants and existing applicants who missed an offer in the December round or who have now been offered a course higher in their preference list.

Also included in the January round of offers are people who were offered places in the December round but had chosen to wait in the hope of being offered one of their higher preferences in the later round. The universities have reoffered 1,392 places (1,295 last year) to applicants who chose to use this 'safety net' for their December round offer.

There are always a number of people who do not take up their offers or who choose to defer studies until the following year. There are 925 applicants who have not accepted their first preference offer from the December round (1,177 last year). A further 1,317 applicants have chosen to defer their study until 2020 (1,532 at the same time last year).
