1 APPLICATION OPENING DATE

Applications through TISC for Semester 1 2027 admission will open on Tuesday 2 June 2026.

2 EARLY OFFERS FOR 2027 ADMISSION

Students applying through TISC will automatically be considered for an early offer for their **first preference**, if that course makes early offers. There is no need to complete any separate or additional procedures to be considered for early offers.

There will be two Year 12 Early Offer rounds this year. The first early offer round will be released on Monday 5 October 2026 and the second and final early offer round will be released on Wednesday 2 December.

3 TWO-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION

For added security two-factor authentication was implemented last year when using TISOnline. To avoid being locked out of their accounts, we recommend students register for both available verification methods: an authenticator application and SMS. An authenticator app to generate the verification codes, and SMS to a mobile to receive the codes.

We would suggest students use an authenticator application that can be downloaded from an app store as their primary verification option. These applications have no limitation and can be used overseas while SMS has a limitation on the number of messages that can be sent and can only be used overseas if the mobile has global roaming.

4 2027 TISC GUIDE

The 2027 TISC Guide will be a digital-only publication, in line with most other Australian states. The TISC Guide will be available as a full PDF download (which can be printed as required) and as an embedded flip book. The publication date is yet to be confirmed but is expected to be in mid-July.

5 PERSONALISED LETTERS TO YEAR 12 STUDENTS

If your school would like to receive a PDF batch of your students' personalised letters, which you can then print or distribute electronically (eg email, SEQTA), please email applications@tisc.edu.au with the subject line "Request for Year 12 personalised letters". These will be sent as **one batch per requesting school**. Letters cannot be sent individually.

Your email must come from an official school email address and include an official email signature. TISC reserves the right to conduct further verification of the sender's right to request this information before supplying the file. For those who do not receive personalised letters, an information sheet about Year 12 students' initial login details is available on the TISC website under [Resources>Downloads>Year 12](#).

6 TISC PRESENTATIONS TO SCHOOLS IN 2026

TISC representatives are available to provide presentations to groups of teachers, career practitioners, Year 12 students and/or parents from now until August. These presentations can be done in person, or online via Microsoft Teams, subject to resourcing and travel time. Please note that bookings may be changed for operational reasons, but TISC would contact you to arrange another suitable time.

Microsoft Bookings will automatically send a confirmation email to the email address used for the booking, one week before the booking date. We ask that you consider either using a general school email address that will be monitored or contacting TISC to update the booking contact details if there is a staff change.

Due to resourcing constraints *TISC can only accommodate one visit per school per year*. If you are looking for more than that, we suggest the following alternatives:

- Two consecutive presentations on the same day may be considered as one booking provided the total booking time is not more than two hours.
- Talk with neighbouring schools to see if you can join forces and arrange joint sessions.

Please note that TISC intends to produce the school presentation in video format this year which can be used in lieu of an in-person presentation.

Presentations to major regional centres (Geraldton, Kalgoorlie, the South West and the Great Southern) are usually arranged in set weeks to enable our presenter to travel. TISC will contact regional schools in these areas to arrange their presentations in accordance with the availability of our presenters. If your school is in one of the above regional areas and you have not received contact regarding a presentation, please contact TISC on 9318 8000 or email schools@tisc.edu.au to book. Online presentations provide flexibility outside those windows.

The PowerPoint presentation available on the TISC website is updated from time to time through the year as new information becomes available.

7 UNIVERSITY COURSE GUIDES 2027

TISC co-ordinates the despatch of the university Course Guides on behalf of the five universities in WA each year. This despatch was completed earlier this month.

Following feedback from schools and to be environmentally friendly, the universities have reduced the number of Course Guides that were sent to schools this year. The number of course guides sent to your school may vary for each university. If you require additional copies of this year's Course Guides, please contact the Prospective Students Offices at the Universities.
